

How to remove an acid etch mark from granite and marble counter tops, or ceramic tile

Magica rust remover is a great way to remove rust stains, but it needs to be kept away from highly polished surfaces as noted on the label of every bottle. If Magica gets on these surfaces by mistake, rinse with water immediately. In most cases it will not leave a mark if washed off quickly. If you have a situation where Magica was left on for a while it may etch the surface, making it look dull and hazy. We occasionally get calls from customers looking for a way to repair this damage. There are several ways to do this, here are few we can recommend.

For ceramic tile you can use a scratch removing foam pad and a polishing compound.
